## 2017 STUDENT ART CONTEST GUIDELINES

Contest Theme: Human Trafficking

- **All entry forms and accompanying submissions must be submitted to the Elizabeth Fry Society by noon, Friday March 31, 2017**
- Competition is open to high school students attending any high school within the boundaries of Prince George
- Submissions may include computer generated-artwork, paintings, or drawings
- No group submissions
- Submissions may be in English or French
- Only one entry per student
- All artwork submissions must be human trafficking themed. Use of sexually explicit imagery is prohibited and will automatically disqualify an entry
- All submissions must be original, titled, signed, and suitable for public display.
- No photograph submissions will be accepted
- Artwork must be original; Submissions using copyrighted images or art will be automatically disqualified
- If submitting computer generated artwork, only a printed copy of the artwork will be accepted
- If submitting a drawing, painting, sketch, etc., the artwork must not exceed 48" x 60"
- A completed entry form must accompany all submissions.
- Submissions will be panel-judged based on message creativity and co-relation to the theme.
- Selected art will be displayed in the upcoming Human Trafficking Information Booklet
- Art submissions will be featured in an art exhibit evening event
- The Elizabeth Fry Society may make available for reproduction any entry under this program by any means, including the Elizabeth Fry Society website, hard copies, or in various electronic forms, without restriction. The entries may be freely distributed and used by the Elizabeth Fry Society for non-commercial and educational purposes only
- Entrants must agree to the release of rights to their artwork, and any photos taken of the artist at any event related to the Elizabeth Fry Society Human Trafficking art competition.
- Although we promise to provide reasonable care, the Elizabeth Fry Society and its employees assume no responsibility and are not liable for lost or damaged submissions
- Winners will be notified in April, 2017
