TRANSITION HOUSE WORKER (CASUAL)

The Elizabeth Fry Society is accepting applications for casual positions in Burns Lake. The successful candidates will provide services to women who are at risk of violence, threats or abuse. These positions will carry the responsibility of providing a safe and supportive living environment where women can feel free to seek crisis intervention and referral support.

A diploma in human services or related field or equivalent education and experience is typically required. First Aid and/or Food Safe would be an asset to the position.

The successful candidates will have good interpersonal communication – both oral and written skills, knowledge of violence in relationships, substance misuse, and the effects of trauma and systemic pressures that marginalize women and their dependent children. Knowledge of working with First Nations' families is required. Knowledge of victim's rights, community agencies and referral procedures are necessary. A feminist analysis of the dynamics of abuse and violence is required. Good working ability to maintain general upkeep of a home. Computer knowledge, well developed organizational skills and ability to work independently and in amongst a team.

These positions require working days, evenings, weekends and overnights.
These positions require Union membership.
